

Dear Wayne:

This letter agreement is between the Government of Iceland ("Iceland") and Berman Enterprises, Inc. in partnership with the Rogich Communications Group ("Consultant") and relates to certain consulting services to be rendered by Consultant to Iceland with respect to assisting in achieving Iceland's objectives in furtherance of the historic alliance between Iceland and the United States.

The term of this agreement shall commence as of March 1, 2003 and continue through May 31, 2003. The term may be extended by mutual written agreement.

In consideration of such aforementioned consulting services rendered or to be rendered, Iceland will pay Consultant \$25,000 per month for the first 3 month period (March 1, 2003 through May 31, 2003). The contract is renewable for one year by mutual agreement. The renewal period fee structure may be adjusted by mutual agreement based on need. Iceland will also reimburse Consultant for certain approved expenses.

All invoices submitted by Consultant relating to amounts due under this agreement shall describe the services or expenses incurred.

All information which Consultant presently has or which may come into Consultant's possession during the engagement relative to the business activities of Iceland or its affiliates and subsidiaries is of a secret or confidential nature and shall remain the property of Iceland. Consultant shall not, during the engagement or thereafter, disclose to others or use for the benefit of others or itself any such information so long as such information is treated as secret or confidential by Iceland.

Consultant represents and warrants that it is in compliance with all applicable federal, state, local laws, rules and regulations, including ethics rules governing conflicts of interest. Consultant further represents and warrants that it is qualified under all applicable laws, rules and regulations to perform the services rendered or to be rendered under this agreement. Consultant finally represents that it will register under the Lobbying Disclosure Act and the Foreign Agents Registration Act if required by law.

This agreement is intended for the sole and exclusive benefit of Iceland and Consultant.
