

The Hmong people in many parts in the jungle of Laos is under strict controlled and monitor by the LaoPDR military that constantly launched attacks with heavy artillery shells, placed mines, spread chemical agents, and the use starvation as a weapon of war on civilians. LaoPDR regime evicted Hmong people from their lands, properties, and prohibited their ways of life, culture, religious choice, and written language.



The duties of the Hmong Foreign Council is to act on the behalf of the Hmong Freedom League based in northern Laos to officially represent them in the United States and the international communities to address the on-going human rights violations, atrocity, and genocide committed by the LaoPDR regime since 1975. LaoPDR must ratify and be compliance to the two international covenant on human rights in which LaoPDR is a signatory to on December 7, 2000. The United States and the international communitis cannot allow LaoPDR to remain defiant and LaoPDR must be held accountable for their abuses.
