On October 30, in cooperation with Congressman Trent Franks[AZ-R] and Congressman Cleaver [MO-D] with guest speakers like Chaplain Daniel P, Coughlin who spoke about the hope for a better future of peace for the Naga people. Ambassador John McDonald encouraged the Nagas to look at some of the positive peaceful solutions made by Kashmir.

It is for these reasons I quite often cannot recoup the promised salary in a timely fashion and then when I am paid I have to pay out past bills of overhead expenses that dip into my personal salary. However the foreign principal GPRN/NSCN(I-M) does their best to cover my living expenses. travel and food


