TO EDUCATE THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY INCLUDING U.S. CONGRESS, ADMINISTRATION, POLITICAL PARTIES REGARDING THE SIKH STRUGGLE FOR THE INDEPENDENCE OF KHALISTAN FROM INDIAN OCCUPATION AND REPRESSION OF THE SIKHS BY THE INDIAN GOVT. WHICH RESULTED IN THE MURDER OF OVER 250,000 SIKHS IN ADDITION 50,000 SIKH WERE TORTURED BY INDIAN POLICE, THEN MURDERED AND CREMATED BY DECLARING THEM UNIDENTIFIED.

TO EDUCATE THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY, U.S. CONGRESS, U.S. ADMINISTRATION BY PROVIDING THEM INFORMATION REGARDING THE SIKH STRUGGLE FOR INDEPENDENCE, ITS PERSECUTION BY THE INDIAN GOVT WHICH RESULTED IN THE MURDER OF OVER 250,000 SIKHS, ANOTHER 50,000 WAS TORTURED THEN MURDERED BY DECLARING THEM UNIDENTIFIED BODIES. HUMAN RIGHTS ACTIVIST JASWANT SINGH KHALRA, AKAL TAKHAT JATHEDAR BHAI GURDEV SINGH KAUNKE LIKE OVER 50,000 OTHERS WERE TORTURED AND THEN MURDERED AND CREMATED THEIR BODIES OR EVEN ASHES WERE NOT GIVEN TO THEIR FAMILIES. AMNESTY INT'L IS NOT ALLOWED TO VISIT PUNJAB SINCE 1978. THERE ARE PICTURES OF TORTURED BODIES OF THE SIKHS. BABA CHARAN SINGH, A RELIGIOUS SIKH MISSIONARY WAS MURDERED BY INDIA POLICE BY TYING HIS LEGS TO TWO JEeps THEN MOVED IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION TEARING APART HIS BODY INTO TWO. THESE POLICE OFFICIALS WHO MURDERED AND TORTURED SIKH WERE REWARDED WITH PROMOTION BY THE BRUTAL TYRANT INDIA GOVT
