

Although Baker & Hostetler LLP has agreed to represent the Government of the Republic of Croatia, the terms and conditions of this representation have not been formally settled. It is expected that Croatia will pay legal fees based upon the time expended by Firm attorneys on its behalf, as well as expenses and disbursements. It is anticipated that a formal written fee agreement will be concluded shortly, and a copy of this agreement will be filed with the Department at that time.

Baker & Hostetler LLP has agreed to represent the Government of the Republic of Croatia before the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia in The Hague, The Netherlands. In addition, the Firm has agreed to represent the Government of the Republic of Croatia before the Government of the United States in connection with matters related to the Hague Tribunal. This work will be performed by a number of the Firm's lawyers, with assistance from staff as may be required.


