Thanks very much for your congratulations. I did bring the victory as predicted.



Best wishes to you, your family, and colleagues for the New Year! Thank you for your letter dated January 9, 2004.

The proposal from The Lugano Group Incorporated for a New York City investment promotion visit by Prime Minister Keith Mitchell was first discussed with Minister Brenda Hood in June 2003. Prime Minister Mitchell at our meeting on July 14, 2003 in Brooklyn expressed his interest in pursuing the trip after elections. Our idea at The Lugano Group is that the designated date of Monday, February 23, 2004 be devoted to promoting Grenada's investment opportunities. This visit will be a highly targeted effort to attract investors based upon the Government's economic development priorities. The Lugano Group proposes to organize a presentation to potential investors and interviews with both electronic and print financial press. Prime Minister Mitchell's investment promotion visit also could be used to announce the proposed "Grenada Week" in New York that Minister Hood and I have discussed. The trip's highlight will be a visit to the New York Stock Exchange for meetings with market officials and a high-profile trading floor tour.

On behalf of Prime Minister Mitchell, The Lugano Group will organize all meetings and press interviews as well as the New York Stock Exchange visit. The comprehensive cost of our services is US\$12,000. This encompasses a US\$8,000 fee and US\$4,000 for expenses. We request that one-third of the total amount, US\$4,000, be paid as a retainer by Monday, February 2, 2004. Please send a letter confirming the Government's agreement with these terms. We also ask that a list of the investment opportunities that the Government would like to promote be sent to us forthwith.
