GOVERNMENT RELATIONS CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Agreement will serve to confirm representation and consulting services to be provided by Scribe Strategies & Advisors ("Scribe"), located at 1050 Connecticut Avenue, NW, Suite 1000, Washington, DC 20036, to the Embassy of the Republic of Korea ("Korea"), located at 2450 Massachusetts Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20008.

(1) **Scope of Work:** There are a number of key issues that are being considered by the Administration and Congress that affect the U.S.-Korea bilateral relationship. Scribe is fully prepared to assist Korea with certain important elements of the broader agenda. Specific issues to be addressed will be communicated on a regular basis to Scribe by Korea.

Scribe is a firm that has a deep commitment and abiding friendship towards Korea, with a unique perspective of understanding the complexities that govern the bilateral relationship. We believe that our combination of skills and capabilities aligned with a personal "passion" for the issues will ensure Korea that we effectively communicate a message to elevate and broaden the U.S. perception of the alliance partnership. We will seek to achieve this through strategic communication, public relations and policy education.

In our discussions, as Korea has identified the services which it wants Scribe to provide under the form of advice, counsel, strategic planning, and media and communications development, Scribe will itself register under the terms of the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1937 (FARA), as amended, in order to fully comply with United States law. Furthermore, this Agreement shall be in full compliance with the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act and all other U.S. legal requirements.

(2) **The Scribe Team:** The full resources of Scribe will be made available to Korea throughout the duration of this Agreement. Thomas S. Kim, Senior Vice President, will personally lead, oversee and manage the Scribe team, and he will be assisted by Joseph Szlavik, President, and other members of Scribe as needed or required. Biographies of all of Scribe's professionals will be provided upon request.

(3.) **Fee & Expenses:** With the abovementioned aim, Scribe, will receive a retainer fee of US\$10,000 per month for a period of three (3) months for the described services. The period will commence on October 1, 2005 and end on December 31, 2005. Payment of the full amount of US\$30,000 will be made to Scribe and due in its entirety up front. Wire transfer instructions will be provided in a separate document (Exhibit "A"). In addition, Korea shall reimburse Scribe for certain extraordinary costs and expenses, including, printing, travel, lodging, special projects and out-of-pocket expenses undertaken by Scribe for Korea, provided that prior approval for such expenses shall have been confirmed by Korea in writing. Scribe promises to provide the services described in the preceding paragraphs of this agreement, under the management of Thomas S. Kim, assisted by Scribe professionals.




