

We have reviewed the records and our findings follow:

1. Period ending March 31, 2006. We find no disbursement by me or Alliance Consulting Group on behalf of my foreign principal for any of the activities listed in the report for that period.
2. Period ending September 30, 2006. I was a guest for lunch at the residence of the US Ambassador to Panama on June 5, 2006. During that lunch discussions related to US-Panama relationship took place. There was no disbursement of funds on my behalf or Alliance Consulting Group, to attend the lunch, as I was a guest of the US Ambassador at his home in Panama.

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3. Period ending March 31, 2007. I had lunch with Juan Zarate, Deputy Assistant to the President, National Security Council, to discuss upcoming trip of President Torrijos of Panama with President Bush. The lunch occurred on January 12, 2007 at the Oval Room Restaurant in Washington DC. I paid for my lunch, \$37.00 and Mr. Zarate paid for his lunch as required by White House rules. We have amended this report accordingly.
