

Privacy Act Statement. 

Dear Mr. Talabany,

We are honored by the decision to engage Greenberg Traurig, LLP to represent the Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG) in the United States at this pivotal time in the history of the Kurdish people.

The representation entails work that will require public disclosure under the Foreign Agents Registration Act (FARA). This law requires us to register and report our activities on behalf of Kurdistan. If you have any questions regarding the circumstances relating to compliance with FARA, we should discuss.

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


