

Privacy Act Statement. 

General Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT made this 15 day of June, 2006, by and between Mark Edmond Clark of 218 East 81st Street, Suite 4B, NY, NY 10028 (First Party), and Mission of I.R. Iran to the United Nations of 622 3rd Avenue 34th FL., NY, NY 10017 (Second Party).

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements to be kept and performed on the part of said parties hereto, respectively as herein stated, the said party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree that it shall:

I. Said party of the first part covenants and agrees that it shall:

- A) Coordinate with Mr. Gholamhossein Mohammadnia, or other staff at the Iranian Mission to the UN when requested, on topics to examine on US-Iran relations.
- B) Advise Mission staff on the development of communications (i.e., policy statements, policy notes, press releases, and letters) for the sole and exclusive use of the Mission.
- C) Contact and attend the meetings of foreign policy, business, and professional associations as requested by Mission staff
- D) Attempt to create opportunities for Mission staff to meet with individuals when requested and for Mission staff to attend meetings of foreign policy, business, and professional associations when possible.
- E) Write occasional reports on US-Iran relations in coordination with Mission staff for the Mission's sole and exclusive use.

II. And said party of the second part covenants and agrees that it shall:

- A) Make payments of \$4,000 per month by check from the Mission for personal service, paid on the first day of each month for a twelve month total of \$48,000.
- B) Make separate payments by check from the Mission for all other than personal service expenses (i.e., travel and accommodations) within ten days after Mr. Clark presents a receipt for those expenses..
- C) Possibly increase the payment to Mr. Clark per month starting at \$1,000 during the project based on performance.


III. Other terms to be observed by and between the parties:


- A) The initial time parameter for Mr. Clark's project for the Mission shall be twelve months.
- B) The project shall officially start June 15, 2006, and end May 15, 2007.
- C) After the twelve months, both parties must agree to continue the project for another year.
- D) Both parties shall interface regularly by telephone or e-mail to coordinate activities.
- E) In addition to all other meetings between Mr. Clark and Mr. Mohammadnia, a specific meeting will be held at the Mission monthly to evaluate project activities.

This agreement shall be binding upon the parties, their successors, assigns and personal representatives. Time is of the essence on all undertakings. This agreement shall be enforced under the laws of the State of New York. This is the entire agreement.
