



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Dear Mr. Gray:

Thank you for retaining Private Public Solutions, LLC ("PPS") to assist The President of the Republic of the Congo ("The President") for implementing and advancing initiatives to enhance and support US-Congo economic and political relations.

The term of this engagement is from October 15, 2008, through September 30, 2009.

The fee for our services will be a monthly retainer of \$16,000 due on the first day of each month. This monthly retainer includes reasonable and ordinary expenses incurred by us. We will not incur any significant expenses that would be subject to individual billing without prior approval. Additional matters, outside of the scope of this retainer, will be subject to negotiation and separate fees. This agreement may be terminated by either party, for any reason, upon thirty (30) days written notice.

All payments and obligations under this agreement are contingent on receipt of funds by The Amani Group ("Amani") for payment to PPS from Trout Cacheris, PLLC. PPS will not seek any recourse against Amani, or its members, in the event of any failure of Trout Cacheris' to provide for the payment of any sums specified in this agreement. Amani will not make any payments to PPS from United States federally appropriated funds or other funds from restricted or prohibited sources. By signing this engagement agreement, both parties confirm their understanding of and agreement with the foregoing.

PPS will comply with all federal and state laws and regulations applicable to lobbying and any other activities undertaken on behalf of Amani, including, but not limited to, the Lobbying Disclosure Act

of 1995, as amended by the Honest Leadership and Open Government Act of 2007, the Foreign Agents Registration Act, and regulations and guidance issued there under.
