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Honorable Members of the House of Representatives and the Senate

Or Honorable Representatives and Senators,

His Majesty King Mohammed VI acknowledges receipt of your letter regarding the repatriation measures taken against American citizens by the Government of the Kingdom of Morocco.

In accordance with the Instructions of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, Commander of the Faithful, I would like to share with you the following clarifications and remarks on this issue:

1. Freedoms of opinion and expression, in all their forms, are and will remain protected and guaranteed by the Constitution of Morocco, as well as by relevant Moroccan legislation regarding individual and collective public liberties. Everyone can practice these liberties without any restriction whatsoever.

Freedom of expression is also guaranteed by the international commitments taken by the Kingdom of Morocco, whose Constitution enshrines the universally recognized principles of Human Rights.

2. The repatriation measures which concerned, amongst others, a number of American citizens, solely and exclusively targeted proselytism activities which are clearly and categorically forbidden by the precepts of Islam which are vouched for by His Majesty the King, Commander of the Faithful.

Furthermore, these activities are considered an (criminal) offence under Moroccan legislation.

Indeed, articles 220 to 223 of the Moroccan Penal Code make provisions for fines and prison sentences for whomever *“has forced or prevented a single or numerous persons to practice a faith or to participate in the practice of that faith”*. The same sentence is provided for whomever *“uses means of seduction in the aim of undermining a Muslim’s faith or of converting him/ her to another religion, either by exploiting his weaknesses or needs, or through the use, to this end, of health or educational establishments, as well as shelters or orphanages”*.

The inclusion in the Penal Code of references to educational establishments and to orphanages reflects the impressionability of, and the desire to protect,

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young children, and especially those raised without the normal transmission of their Muslim religious faith through their families. While your letter refers exclusively to what you view as the rights of the Americans who were in charge of these children, Moroccan law understandably seeks above all to protect these minors and to preserve the religious faith of their often tragically interrupted family lives.

Under these conditions, there can be no mistake about the intent and attitude of the Moroccan authorities in this case.

The repatriation measures were not taken against the concerned parties in relation to their Christian faith, but because they had committed criminal offences, as proven by an investigation conducted by the relevant legal authority, namely the Crown Prosecution Office, following formal complaints, namely by parents and close relatives of the children concerned.

Under such circumstances, Moroccan authorities were obligated to fulfill their responsibilities by duly enforcing the Law. The choice of an administrative procedure of repatriation - as provided for by national legislation - instead of a legal procedure, was made to spare concerned parties the unavoidable ordeal which would result from a trial, no matter how fair it may be.

As such, in no way whatsoever did the repatriation measures breach freedom of worship, which is guaranteed by the Moroccan Constitution. His Majesty the King, Commander of the Faithful, warrants the exercise of this freedom across the Moroccan territory as a whole and in an equal manner, for Muslims, Jews and Christians of all persuasions.

These repatriation measures should, rather, be construed as logical, legal and legitimate decisions resulting from a thorough investigation which established, on the basis of verifiable and substantial evidence that foreign nationals, under the pretence of conducting charitable actions, had engaged in proselytizing, which is considered an (criminal) offence.

- 3. The Kingdom of Morocco has always been a land of dialogue and exchange, as well as a crossroads where different civilizations, cultures and religions can meet. Moroccan Islam, founded upon values of openness, tolerance and moderation, constitutes a central pillar upholding Moroccan society which needs to be preserved against any undermining or perversions.*

Whenever this serene Islam, fruit of long years of peaceful coexistence between the varied and rich strata of Moroccan society, has been targeted by proselytizing or heretical activities, Moroccan authorities were obliged to act, in all legality, to protect the faith of Moroccan society.

In this context, it should be underlined that repatriation procedures were regularly undertaken, these past years, against some of "our brothers in Islam" both from Shiite or Wahhabi rites. In these cases, the same type of administrative procedure was followed, for instance in the shutting down of 137 "Diour Al Koran" (koranic schools) and of the Shiite Iraqi school, as well as in context of measures taken against the Moroccan association "MALI" (Alternative Movement for Individual Liberties) for public disorder caused during the holy month of Ramadan.

The reference to the clauses of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights is not relevant given that these clauses apply only to parents and legal guardians of children, which was not the case, as per the Moroccan legislation on the « kafala », of the deported persons.

I take avail of this opportunity to convey the expression of my highest regards.

Formation of a US-Egyptian Interparliamentary Alliance

A growing number of Congress have had the opportunity to become more familiar with the many ways in which Egypt is an essential ally, not only in the Middle East, but throughout the world.

Similarly, members of the Egyptian Parliament are becoming more interested in increasing cooperation and achieving a substantive exchange with their US counterparts on issues of mutual interest and concern.

On a recent visit to Washington, one on which he met with Speaker Pelosi and a number of House members of both parties, the Speaker of the Egyptian Parliament strongly endorsed this idea and pledged his active support to it.

The Egyptian Ambassador to Washington wants to work closely with House leadership of both parties to help make this idea a reality in 2011.

The Concept

To have a relatively small number of lawmakers in each country's legislature come together around issues of common concern.

To have those members meet in person twice a year, once in Egypt and once in the United States.

To seek agreement and common actions on critical issues.

To, thereby, expand and improve the US-Egyptian relationship and the bond between the people of the two countries.

To have the expenses of the Alliance members provided by their committees in accordance with rules of the House Ethics office.

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The Formation of the Alliance

1. On the US side, the alliance will be comprised of US House members; two lawmakers from each of several committees, one Democrat and

one Republican. These will be in almost every instance subcommittee chairs and ranking minority members.

2. The lawmakers will gain approval from their full committee chairman/woman for their travel and related expenses to be covered by the full committee budget.(note: this approach has been fully vetted with appropriate House officials and is consistent with the ethics rules)
3. The Egyptian side will select parliamentarians in the same manner, from committees with jurisdictions similar to their US counterparts.
4. The Egyptian side expenses will be covered by their Parliament's budget under the direction of the Speaker.

Committees of Interest in the US House of Representatives

- 1. Foreign Affairs Committee – focus on anti-terrorism, foreign assistance, the US foreign policy agenda, international organizations, and human rights.**
- 2. Judiciary Committee – focus on constitutional reform, judicial independence, judicial reform, operation of the courts,**
- 3. Energy and Commerce Committee – focus on health care, energy development and conservation, clean air and clean water, climate change and telecommunications**
- 4. Select Committee on Intelligence – national security, intelligence focus, and other issues of mutual concern.**
- 5. Transportation Committee – focus on aviation, highways, pipelines, railroads**

- 6. Education and Labor Committee – focus on early childhood education, women’s education, higher education, vocational training, labor-management negotiating issues.**
- 7. Natural Resources Committee – focus on protection and utilization of government-owned lands, water preservation and wildlife protection**

The core group on the US side is open to suggestions of other committees and issues that might be of interest to both parliamentary bodies.

The European Union (EU) has assured the Kenya Government of support in its efforts to implement institutional reforms.

The High Representative for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy of the European Union, Baroness Catherine Ashton, encouraged the government to remain steadfast on the reform agenda during a meeting with President Kibaki at Harambee House Wednesday.

Baroness Ashton, who is also the Vice-President of the European Commission, welcomed the progress Kenya has made towards achieving a new constitution.

On piracy in the Indian Ocean, the visiting European Union official commended Kenya for the role it has continued to play in reducing the menace.

She was accompanied by the head of EU delegation to Kenya Eric Van Der Linden, the head of Political and Trade section Mrs Beatrix Knaster-Sanchez and her Regional Political section counterpart Mr Thorsten Bargfrede, among others.

Good relations

Lauding the good relations between Kenya and the European Union, President Kibaki urged the European Union to provide leadership to the international community towards supporting peace initiatives in Somalia.

The President, particularly, said that the problem of piracy in the Indian Ocean required a more coordinated and holistic approach, which should be informed by the principle of fairness and shared international responsibility.

President Kibaki thanked the European Union for supporting Kenya's development efforts, noting that the Kenya Government and the European Union signed an agreement last month that will see Kenya receive Sh15.4 billion for infrastructure development.

A delegation of evangelical church leaders visiting Morocco urged Rep. Frank Wolf on Friday to postpone hearings on the recent expulsion of Christians.

"We believe it is too early to hold hearings because much more time is needed to determine facts and to give this issue the attention it deserves," said the Rev. Dr. David Anderson, spokesman for the delegation.

A hearing, led by Wolf (R-Va.), is scheduled for June 17 to look into the "harsh nature" of the expulsions of more than 40 Christians – some of whom are U.S. citizens – who were accused of proselytizing.

Wolf said in a statement Thursday that he has been working with Moroccan and U.S. officials over the last two months in an attempt to find a satisfactory solution but the "Moroccan government seems unwilling to compromise."

"I feel it is my responsibility to speak out about the human rights abuses being perpetrated by the Moroccan government," he stated.

Proselytism is illegal in the predominantly Muslim country. Though Morocco has been recognized for its religious tolerance and freedom, many Christians expressed concern in recent months with what some believe to be a national crackdown against Christians.

Among those ordered to leave the country were 16 Christians from the Village of Hope who were taking care of 33 orphaned and abandoned children. The workers had been serving as foster parents for some 10 years with the full knowledge of the government and were shocked by the sudden expulsion in March. They refuted proselytism claims and maintained that they have abided by the law.

According to Wolf, 10 additional foreign nationals were asked to leave the country earlier this week. The congressman noted that Moroccan authorities have refused to turn over any evidence or offer any explanation of the proselytism charges.

Along with scheduling a hearing, Wolf has also called on the U.S. State Department and the White House to raise the issue with Moroccan authorities.

But a group of evangelicals who have been talking with government officials and church leaders in Morocco say investigating the matter publicly could do more harm than good.

The five-member team went to Morocco to "quietly pursue a better understanding of the complex circumstances surrounding these deeply troubling events" and so far found that Christians were not the only ones expelled.

Recent deportations have also involved "at least as many Muslims as non-Muslims," said Anderson. With that, and also considering the value of the relationship between the U.S. and Morocco, the delegation urged Wolf to delay any action.

"It's not in anyone's best interests to explore details of these allegations publicly," Anderson stressed from the capital of Rabat on Friday. "This is better handled discretely and sensitively, especially considering the large number of Christians that live in Morocco."

According to the delegation, the Moroccan government has issued an invitation to U.S. congressional members and evangelical leaders to visit Morocco and discuss the situation. In addition to Anderson, who is senior pastor of Faith Baptist Church in Sarasota, Fla., members of the delegation include: the Rev. Dr. Kenneth Barney of New Antioch Baptist Church in Randallstown, Md., the Rev. Patrick J. Mahoney of the Christian Defense Coalition, the Rev. Dr. Rob Schenck of National Clergy Council, and the Rev. Dr. Harry Thomas of Come Alive International.
