

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

Dear Mr. Coleman:

This letter is to set forth the terms on which GrayLoeffler, LLC ("GrayLoeffler") will assist Levant Suez Consulting Corporation ("Levant") on behalf of Sheikh Fahad Salem Al Ali Al Sabah and the Fahad Al Salem Center for Dialogue Among Civilizations and Defense of Liberty's ("Fahad Al Salem Center") with respect to Sheikh Fahad and the Fahad Al Salem Center's government affairs, public relations, and business advisory needs in the United States.

Billing Matters

The total fee for our services will be \$450,000.00 (USD). Prior to the commencement of work under this agreement Levant will pay \$270,000.00 (USD) of the fee upon execution of this agreement and the balance of the fee prior to March 23, 2011. The fee referenced above is inclusive all expenses to be incurred by GrayLoeffler as part of this engagement. For the purpose of this agreement, expenses shall include but not be limited to all reasonable expenditures for travel, meals, messengers, mail postage, freight and delivery cost, and duplication and printing costs. GrayLoeffler reserves the right to decline to continue to provide services to clients who do not pay within the guidelines without making mutually acceptable arrangements for delayed payments. By signing this engagement, Levant confirms its understanding of and agreement with the foregoing.

Document Procedures

GrayLoeffler's policy is to deliver to the client, upon request, all documents and property the client has provided GrayLoeffler and documents and materials prepared as part of the representation. We may exclude from this our internal memoranda and records, notes, drafts not intended for external distribution, and similar working materials. We may also elect to retain a

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copy of other portions of the file at our expense. GrayLoeffler will retain in accordance with our records retention program any files relating to client matters that the client does not ask to have returned. However, to avoid indefinite storage, GrayLoeffler reserves the right to dispose of any documents or other materials retained by us within a reasonable time after the completion of this engagement. If the client is in breach of the client's retainer agreement with GrayLoeffler, GrayLoeffler may choose to withhold certain portions of the client files.

Conflicts

GrayLoeffler will comply with all federal and state laws and regulations applicable to lobbying and any other activities undertaken on behalf of Levant, Shiekh Fahad or the Fahad Al Salem Center, including, but not limited to, the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995, as amended by the Honest Leadership and Open Government Act of 2007, as well as the Foreign Agent Registration Act, and any other applicable laws and regulations.

GrayLoeffler and its employees shall not be liable for any liabilities, costs and expenses (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees and expenses) incurred or suffered by reason of, or in any way relating to, this engagement other than as judicially determined to be caused by GrayLoeffler's own bad faith, willful misconduct or negligence. 


