

Question 11

Ministry of Commerce, Government of Pakistan

The registrant's activities on behalf of the foreign principal are to represent the Ministry of Commerce regarding its commercial and trade objectives vis a vis the U.S. Government and private sector. For this reporting period, activities have primarily focused on assisting in the establishment of Reconstruction Opportunity Zones (ROZ) through the introduction and passing of U.S. legislation based on the U.S. Administration's ROZ initiative introduced to Congress. A list of contacts with U.S. officials for this reporting period is attached hereto as Attachment C.

Government of Ethiopia

The large majority of the registrant's activities on behalf of the foreign principal are non-registerable activities connected with the provision of legal counseling concerning the foreign principal's dispute with the State of Eritrea. The registrant represents and advises the foreign principal with respect to various aspects of its dispute with the State of Eritrea, including with respect to proceedings before the International Boundary Commission and Claims Commission in The Hague established pursuant to the December 2000 Peace Agreement between Ethiopia and Eritrea. In addition, the registrant provides advice and professional services to the foreign principal on related matters as requested by the foreign principal. Such representation from time to time includes contacting various Executive Branch officials, officials of government agencies, and members and staff of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives regarding issues relating to the foreign principal, including its dispute with the State of Eritrea. The registrant may also contact members of the U.S. media on behalf of the foreign principal. A list of such contacts for this reporting period is attached hereto as Attachment B.

Question 12

Ministry of Commerce, Government of Pakistan

For Ministry of Commerce, Government of Pakistan, our activities focused on work to promote legislation to establish Reconstruction Opportunity Zones (ROZs) introduced to Congress by the U.S. Administration. Our political activity consisted of contacts with members of Congress and staff and officials in the executive branch as well as organizing Pakistani government and business delegations to meet with U.S. government contacts. A list of such activities for this reporting period is attached hereto as Attachment C.
