### Question 11:

#### Government of Republika Srpska

The registrant's activities on behalf of the foreign principal are to advise the government on matters related to international law. This work includes the provision of written and oral advice to members of the government as requested. From time to time this advice may be provided in writing. From time to time the government may request that we provide information related to such advice to members of the U.S. Administration and/or Congress. Such information relates to the law and policy of the government's relations with the United States and other international organizations and sovereign states. A list of contacts with U.S. officials during this reporting period is attached hereto as Attachment C.

#### Government of Ethiopia

The large majority of the registrant's activities on behalf of the foreign principal are non-registerable activities connected with the provision of legal counseling concerning the foreign principal's dispute with the State of Eritrea. The registrant represents and advises the foreign principal with respect to various aspects of its dispute with the State of Eritrea, including with respect to proceedings before the International Boundary Commission and Claims Commission in The Hague established pursuant to the December 2000 Peace Agreement between Ethiopia and Eritea. In addition, the registrant provides advice and professional services to the foreign principal on related matters as requested by the foreign principal. Such representation from time to time includes contacting various Executive Branch officials, officials of government agencies, and members and staff of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives regarding issues relating to the foreign principal, including its dispute with the State of Eritrea. The registrant may also contact members of the U.S. media on behalf of the foreign principal. No such contacts have been made during this reporting period.

### Question 12:

#### Government of Republika Srpska

The registrant's activities include contacting various Executive Branch officials, officials of government agencies, and members of the staff of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives regarding issues related to the foreign principal including its relations with the United States, other sovereign states, and international organizations.
