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**CONSULTING AGREEMENT**


This consulting agreement (the "Agreement") is made between The Royal Hashemite Court ("the RHC") and Vinca LaFleur of West Wing Writers LLC of 1150 Connecticut Avenue, N.W., Suite 505, Washington DC 20036 (the "Consultant").

1. Services. The Consultant will assist the RHC with the draft preparation of public remarks and written communications for the Office of Her Majesty Queen Rania Al-Abdullah, as may be requested by the RHC and as mutually agreed to by the parties. The Consultant will have no role in the publication, distribution, dissemination, or transmittal of these works.
2. Terms and Termination. This Agreement is a one-year contract commencing in February 2008, with the option to extend upon agreement of both parties. The parties will review the Agreement after six months, at which point the Agreement may be adjusted upon agreement of both parties. Either party may terminate this Agreement at any time without cause after providing 30 days written notice to the other party.
3. Compensation. For services performed by the Consultant under this Agreement, the RHC will pay the Consultant \$6,500 per month, to be invoiced bimonthly commencing March 1, 2008 for the months of February and March 2008.
4. Expenses. The RHC will reimburse the Consultant for all reasonable and necessary out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the Consultant in the performance of services under this Agreement, including but not limited to expenses for research, travel, and accommodations.


