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CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Dear Mr. Sassine:

On behalf of Sorini, Samet & Associates LLC (SSA), I am very pleased to provide you with this proposal for professional services to advance the goals and objectives of the Société Nationale des Parcs Industriels (SONAPI).

As we have discussed, the activities of SSA will focus on the trade and investment interests of SONAPI. Given the prior detailed and long standing experience of SSA in supporting the enactment of the U.S. HOPE and HELP legislation and with investment promotion activities in the manufacturing sector of Haiti, SSA will support SONAPI on trade and investment concerns going forward.

Specifically, SSA will provide support to SONAPI on the continued implementation and compliance with the requirements of the HOPE and HELP legislation, with specific reference to the labor and social compliance obligations of the legislation. This will include both technical advice on the requirements for implementation, and supporting officials of SONAPI in meeting with the US Government, US Congress, international organizations, and other interested stakeholders, including the private sector, on the implementation of the legislation and programs related to it.

In addition, SSA will support officials of SONAPI in work related to investment promotion and development of the industrial zones of Haiti. This work will relate to specific targeted investment promotion identified by SONAPI for meetings in Washington, D.C. with US or international organizations and firms related to development of investment in export processing zones.

Sorini, Samet & Associates, LLC
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This contract will be for a one year period beginning February 1, 2013 and going through January 31, 2014. SONAPI agrees to remit to SSA by wire transfer to the bank account designated by SSA \$5,000.00 (Five Thousand US Dollars) per month billable the first of each month beginning on February 1, 2013 and ending January 31, 2014. Out-of-pocket expenses for normal business expenses such as taxis, telephone, shipping charges, and similar related cost will be billed separately, but not to exceed \$250.00 in any month without the pre-approval of SONAPI. Any travel expenses will be in addition to the monthly fees and air travel will be at business class rates. Travel expenses must be pre-approved by SONAPI.

Either SSA or SONAPI has the right to terminate this agreement with thirty (30) days written notice. If SONAPI exercises the right to terminate this agreement fees for months during which the contract is in effect will still be payable to SSA.

SSA agrees to fulfill its obligations to register and report any lobbying activity on behalf of SONAPI. Depending on the status of SONAPI, registration and reporting of lobbying activity is governed by either the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 as amended 2 U.S.C. 1601 et seq. (LDA) or the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended 22 U.S.C. §§ 611-621; 28 C.F.R. Part 5 (FARA). Registration under FARA is required for foreign governments, foreign political parties or entities owned in whole or part by either. Lobbying for all other entities is registered under the LDA.

With regard to reporting under FARA, if SONAPI is owned or controlled by the government of Haiti, SONAPI will affirmatively disclose this status in writing to SSA with the execution of this agreement. If SONAPI is not in whole or in part owned or controlled by a foreign government, then SONAPI will certify to this effect in writing with the execution of the Contract and any lobbying activity will be covered by the disclosure requirements of the LDA.

With regard to reporting requirements under the LDA, if there is any non-U.S. entity that (a) holds at least a 20% equitable ownership in SONAPI, (b) directly or indirectly, plans, supervises, controls, directs, finances, or subsidizes activities of SONAPI with regard to the activities under the Contract, or (c) is an affiliate of SONAPI and has a direct interest in the outcome of the activities covered under the Contract, then Client agrees to affirmatively disclose such relationships in written form to SSA with the execution of the Contract. If there are no such relationships, Client certifies to this effect by execution of the Contract.

SONAPI also agrees to timely notify SSA of any change in foreign ownership status.

This agreement can be extended by mutual agreement of the parties in writing, and any changes to this agreement must be in writing.
