- (1) Advocacy efforts on behalf of Congressional support of the SAVE our Industries Act (H.R. 2387 & S. 1244 of the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress), which would expand textile and apparel trade between the United States and the Philippines. This included the scheduling of meetings in the Congress and with Administration officials for Philippines officials, and Filipino and U.S. private sector interests in support of the SAVE Act, and the preparation of materials for such meetings.
- (2) Support for the Philippines Government and private sector representatives in engaging the United States on labor issues relevant for bilateral trade relations, including the SAVE Act, by providing input and memoranda to the delegation on positions for such engagement, and discussing the issues with Congressional staff, and non-governmental organizations and trade unions, and the Philippine private sector interests.
- (3) Support activities for the effort of the Philippines Government and private sector to conduct outreach to the Filipino-American community for the purpose of promoting the Community's engagement with Congress on the SAVE Act.
- (4) Scheduling and briefing support for the visit of a Philippines government delegation to Washington in September 2011. The delegation of September 21, 2011 was led by Secretary Gregory Domingo of the Department of Trade & Industry, and included DTI Undersecretary Adrian Cristobal and Commercial Attaché Josephine Romero. The delegation met with Congressional offices.
