Dear Mr. Ambassador:

As you are aware, I have long supported the efforts of the people of Taiwan to advance the democratic process. Throughout the years, I have urged the United States Government to continue to support Taiwan and to provide arms sales in accordance with the Taiwan Relations Act. I am deeply disappointed that President Obama has refused to advance the sale of the F-16 aircraft. I do not believe the President's actions reflect the prevailing attitude in the U. S. Congress. Unfortunately the action signals an inconsistency in our foreign policy toward Taiwan.

In 1986 as a member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee and Chairman of the Pacific and East Asia subcommittee, I was asked to participate in overseeing the Philippine election process. The group was headed by Senator Lugar, and the candidates were Marcos and Aquino. We were asked to go out in the rural neighborhoods and to observe the voting process. I really believe our presence there was a stabilizing factor in insuring that the election process was transparent and open and that the U. S. Government was totally supportive of the free election process. It is my hope that by lending my support to the upcoming election in Taiwan it will be seen as a reaffirmation of the democratic process we all cherish.

I have been asked to support an effort in Taiwan led by "The International Committee for Fair Elections in Taiwan" and to lend my name along with many others who support free elections in Taiwan. A copy of the
