Republic of Côte d'Ivoire: Covington & Burling LLP is retained to provide advice on international legal and policy matters related to the outcome of the recent presidential elections in Côte d'Ivoire, including the refusal of Mr. Laurent Gbagbo to leave office in accordance with the result certified by the United Nations. Covington & Burling LLP met with business leaders to discuss economic conditions in Côte d'Ivoire and the steps taken by the Ouattara government to ensure that tax and other financial payments flow to government accounts.
