Locke Lord Strategies (the registrant) assisted the Embassy in promoting legislation that would positively impact Pakistan, including H.R. 6387 Afghanistan-Pakistan Security and Prosperity Enhancement Act and S. 3263 Enhanced Partnership with Pakistan Act of 2008 by contacting U.S. Government officials and staff. The registrant made the following contacts to promote support of the H.R. 6387 and S. 3263: meeting on June 18 with Senator Hagel and Ambassador Haqqani; meeting on June 26 with Congressman Chris Van Hollen and Ambassador Haqqani; meeting on July 1 and email on September 10 with Karen Robb, Chief of Staff to Congressman Chris Van Hollen; email on August 19 and phone call on August 20 to Julie Merberg, Legislative Director to Congressman Silvestre Reyes; Email and phone call on August 22 and email on September 10 and September 26 to Andy Wright, Counsel for the Subcommittee on National Security and Foreign Affairs; meeting on September 9 with Jennifer Stewart, Policy Advisor and Joe Barton, Legislative Assistant to Congressman John Boehner; meeting on September 10 with Paul Berkowitz, Foreign Affairs Advisor to Congressman Dana Rohrabacher; phone call on September 10 to Ashley Fishburn, Legislative Assistant to Congressman Adam Putnam; email on September 10 to Jennifer Stewart, Policy Advisor to Congressman Roy Blunt; email on September 12 to Brian Diffel, Senior Policy Advisor to Congressman Roy Blunt; meeting on September 12 with Congressman Roy Blunt, House Minority Whip; email on September 16 to Scott Allen, Regional Advisor for South Asia for US Department of State Office of Counterterrorism. The registrant honored the newly appointed ambassador to the United States, Husain Haqqani by organizing a reception to meet members of Congress and members of the business community in Washington, DC on July 30. The registrant contacted the members of House and Senate Leadership, the House Foreign Affairs Committee, House Armed Services Committee,

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House Appropriations Subcommittee on State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs, Senate Foreign Relations Committee, Senate Armed Services Committee, and Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs to invite them to the reception.
