

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On December 2, 2008, Bill Broydrick made calls to Richard Holbrooke (U.N. Ambassador) regarding relations with Turkey, the U.S. and Kurdistan. A briefing was held with Falah Mustafa Bakir (KRG) and Qubad Talabany (KRG) in preparation for the Gen. Scowcroft meeting. A KRG meeting was held with Bill Broydrick on December 9 and Gen. Scowcroft regarding relations with Kurdistan and Turkey.

On December 22, 2008, a meeting with Ambassador Holbrooke, Bill Broydrick and Qubad Talabany took place regarding on relationships with Turkey, U.S. and Kurdistan. On February 1, 2009, research on the incoming Secretary of State appointment was conducted. Work was done by Bill Broydrick on inaugural tickets for Kurdistan representatives.

Kara Oakley made calls on February 3 to Debora Wada of the House Armed Services Committee regarding appointments. During the week of February 16, Melissa Goldate, Broydrick & Associates intern, worked on UN Ceremony preparations for the anniversary of Halabja on March 16. Cynthia Broydrick conducted outreach to the Oneida Nation for a cultural exchange program with Kurdistan. Bill Broydrick conducted a briefing on Quil Lawrence on Capitol Hill for book presentations.

In March 2009, Bill Broydrick made calls were made to Juan Mendez to prep for UN Anniversary in commemoration of Halabja. He also made calls to the UN Special Envoy. Bill Broydrick called Katherine Porter and Hanny at the UN regarding anniversary of Halabja. More work on UN events was performed throughout the month.

During the week of March 9, Bill Broydrick made calls to Ayal Frank, the lobbyist for Qubad Talabany. Cynthia Broydrick worked to set up New Mexico cultural exchange with Kurdistan. Senator Casey met with Bill Broydrick where Bill briefed him and the staff on the Kurdistan issues. Quil Lawrence event briefing took place on Capitol Hill. On March 25, Jodie Tierney called Brian Williams regarding delivery project and timeline of book distribution.

In March 2009, Fred Starzyk made contacts with Drew Setter, who represents the Pueblo Indian Nation, regarding a visit in preparation for a cultural exchange. In April 2009, Bill Broydrick called Congressman Petri's staff regarding book distribution. Bill Broydrick had an appointment with Bob DeGrasse (Deputy Director of the House Armed Services Committee) regarding CODELs. Research was conducted on Nabucco call for pipeline.

In May 2009, Jodie Tierney and Melissa Goldate distributed Quil Lawrence's book Invisible Nation to House members. Cynthia Broydrick worked on the cultural exchange with Menomonee Indians and conducted research on Cherokee Indians. On May 8, 2009, Bill Broydrick met with Congressman Langevin's staff (RI) to set up a meeting with the Congressman. On May 8, 2009, Bill Broydrick and Qubad Talabany of the KRG met with Congressman Langevin regarding current situations in Kurdistan.

The week of June 3, 2009, Bill Broydrick made contacts with Col. Tart of DOD to discuss CODELs. He also made contacts with John Carr of the Catholic Bishops Conference, Maureen Shea, legislative affairs office of the Episcopal Church, and former Ambassador Warren Clark of Churches for Middle East Peace, regarding meeting with Minister Biato, the Minister of Tourism for Kurdistan.

The week of June 29, 2009, contacts were made with Congressman Pomeroy's office (North Dakota) regarding a congressional briefing and viewing of a film "American Herro." Bill Broydrick attended the North Dakota congressional delegation briefing and film viewing.

Additionally, a meeting was set for Qubad Talabany and William Broydrick, with Senator Casey (Pennsylvania) and Jofi Joseph, the Senator's staff person. The meeting was a general briefing on the situations in Kurdistan.

Cynthia Broydrick and Fred Starzyk continued making arrangements with the Menominee Indian Nation of Wisconsin for a cultural exchange with the Kurds. Cynthia Broydrick contacted Michael Honek from the Dept. of Interior.

On July 12, Bill Broydrick met with Kirk Roos (filmmaker on Kurdistan film – "American Herro"). On August 20, 2009, Bill and Cynthia Broydrick attended the new office opening for the Kurdistan Regional Government. On September 1, Fred Starzyk and Bill Broydrick worked on the Kurdish American Cooperative Caucus. A meeting with Congressman Adam Schiff and staff briefing was conducted by Qubad Talabany.
