American University's Katzen Arts Center to Display *On Normality: Art in Serbia from 1989-2001*

WASHINGTON – The Embassy of the Republic of Serbia, in partnership with the American University Museum at the Katzen Arts Center, will celebrate the opening of the *On Normality: Art in Serbia from 1989-2001* exhibit at the Katzen Arts Center on the campus of American University at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday.

The exhibition is organized by the Museum of Contemporary Art in Belgrade. Artists highlighted in the show worked in Serbia during the reign of Slobodan Milosevic and the associated conflict.

The exhibition shows artistic projects that reflect the political, economic, cultural and day-to-day climate in a country at war. The work portrays a people whose government violently clashes with the country's cultural norms. The artists clearly found themselves caught between direct political engagement and disillusioned escapism, and ultimately between the tragic and the humorous.

Many of the artists participating in the exhibition are well known to the international artistic community but some have never had their works displayed outside of Serbia.

The following artists will have works exhibited: Milan Aleksić, Association Apsolutno, Biljana Djurdjević, Uroš Djurić, Adrian Kovats, Zoran Marinković, Goranka Matić, Era Milivojević, Zoran Naskovski, Vladimir Nikolić, Tanja Ostojić, Vesna Pavlović, Neša Paripović, Talent, Milica Tomić, Zoran Todorović, Raša Todosijević, and Balint Szombathy.

“This is an historic exhibition as it is the first time Serbian modern art is being presented as it's own exhibition in the United States,” said Vladimir Petrovic, Ambassador of Serbia to the United States. “Art is a universal language that enables people from all backgrounds to understand each other's culture and thus offers a unique and important contribution to the dialogue between nations.”
