Rasky Baerlein Strategic Communications has provided strategic communication counsel in support of our goal of generating foreign direct investment from U.S. based companies in Serbia on behalf of our client, the Serbian Investment and Export Promotion Agency (SIEPA). During this six month period, we have facilitated two trips of staff from SIEPA and officials from the Serbian government to Washington D.C. and Boston, MA. These trips included facilitating meetings with elected officials, interviews with media and meetings and interactions with business leaders in order to educate them on the investment opportunities available in Serbia. Our work has also included facilitating a lecture by Deputy Prime Minister Dinkic at Harvard University. In addition, we continue to reach out to media to make Serbian government officials and members of SIEPA available for media interviews on selected topics. We also provide daily news monitoring reports to capture all print and internet coverage of Serbia in the U.S. media market.


