

Dear Ms. Briggs:

This letter, when accepted on behalf of the Abu Dhabi Authority for Culture and Heritage (the "Client") as provided below, will constitute the agreement with respect to the engagement of the Strategic Communications Division of 42West, LLC ("42West"), as communications advisor, specialist, and consultant on the following terms and conditions:

1. The Client, effective as of December 1, 2008, has retained 42West to provide strategic advice and public relations services to The Circle.
2. 42West will bill the Client for its services on a monthly basis at a rate of \$25,000.00 a month, payable at the beginning of each month.
3. Client agrees to indemnify and hold harmless 42West, its shareholders, officers, directors, employees and agents (each such entity or person being referred to as an "Indemnified Person") from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses (including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees) which any Indemnified Person may be subject to or incur in connection with the services rendered by 42West to Client. This paragraph shall not apply to any such losses, claims, damages, liabilities, costs or expenses of any Indemnified Person that are judicially determined to have resulted from 42West's or such other Indemnified Person's gross negligence or willful misconduct.
4. 42West's engagement hereunder may be terminated by either party on 30 days prior written notice. All provisions of this letter relating to the payment of fees and expenses and indemnification, including but not limited to all the provisions contained in paragraphs 4, will survive any termination of the engagement by either party.


