Special projects will be determined and pre-approved by Client on a project-by-project basis and billed separately when the project exceeds the scope of the monthly retainer.


The Agency is hereby authorized by the Client to prepare advocacy and public relations programs, as directed by Client. Said programs and services may include but are not limited to the following:

- E. Other Services. This includes but is not limited to video production services, communications consultation, print production, printing, and development of an advertising plan.


