1. January 22, 2008

Phone conversation with Neil Brown, Professional Staff Member to Senator Richard Lugar on the Senate Foreign Relations Committee. Topics included a summary of Senator Lugar's recent trip to Central Asia where he addressed energy security and pipeline issues. No particular advocacy of Gazprom's positions on these issues occurred during this communication.

2. February 27, 2008

Meeting with Jeff Miller, Chief Counsel to Senator Kohl on the Senate Judiciary Committee. Topics included a discussion of Senator Kohl's NOPEC legislation that would expose gas and oil cartels to extra-territorial jurisdiction. Gazprom's opposition to that legislation was expressed.

3. April 15, 2008

Requested a meeting (drafted a letter for Vin Weber) with Matthew Bryza, Deputy Assistant Secretary for European and Eurasian at the Department of State. The meeting was requested to discuss Bryza's recent comments regarding energy security as well as some disparaging remarks he made regarding Gazprom.
