They met with Michael McFaul, whose title at the time was Special Assistant to the President and Senior Director of Russian and Eurasian Affairs, to discuss international energy security and the Ukrainian gas crisis of 2008-2009. The meeting was in-person at the Old Executive Office Building in Washington, DC. Mr. Schwantes and Mr. Medvedev did not distribute any materials.
