1. Jamal al Dhari is an Iraqi citizen and a leader of one of the largest tribes in Iraq - al Zoba. In 2014, he helped establish Peace Ambassadors for Iraq (PAFI) to: (i) explain to Western audiences the present situation in Iraq, (ii) to explain and promote ideas on how to eliminate ISIS/Daesh and other terrorist groups in Iraq, and (iii) build international support for an all-inclusive Iraq. Sheikh al Dhari receives funds from the al Zoba tribe personally as well as to fund PAFI.

2. Harita Tohme is the Co-Founder and current Chairwoman of Peace Ambassadors for Iraq (PAFI). A prominent Latvian citizen, Ms. Tohme has dedicated her life to enacting change in the world and bringing people together through honest dialogue and meaningful transactions. She is not receiving compensation for her PAFI position or for her work on behalf of PAFI.

Re: Engagement

Dear Paul:

We are pleased that you have asked Nelson Mullins Riley & Scarborough LLP ("Nelson Mullins") to provide strategic counseling and government relations representation to Logan International Relations ("Logan") to assist in your work on behalf of Peace Ambassadors for Iraq ("PAFI"). This letter will confirm our discussions regarding your engagement of Nelson Mullins and will describe the basis on which we will provide services to you. If you have any questions about these provisions, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Scope of Representation

Nelson Mullins will work closely with you to provide a sustained and coordinated effort using our network of relationships and our understanding of government policy and procedure to assist Logan and PAFI.

We will devote our best efforts in representing Logan and PAFI and in doing so we will strictly adhere to both the legal and moral obligations of our profession. Those obligations may include the requirement that we register as lobbyists on your behalf. If registration is required, we will review our lobbying activity on your behalf on a quarterly basis and file the necessary lobbying reports.

The Firm may also provide services for certain immigration petitions and applications with various U.S. federal agencies. Legal services under this engagement will be invoiced separately.

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Fees and Expenses and Term of Engagement

Subject to the terms of this paragraph, Logan will pay Nelson Mullins a monthly retainer of US\$45,000, paid in advance, for services rendered over a period of two (2) months, effective May 15, 2016 through July 15, 2016. The full initial two month fee of US\$90,000 due under this agreement shall be payable upon execution of this engagement.

In addition, Logan will reimburse Nelson Mullins for reasonable and necessary out-of-pocket disbursements and costs; provided, however, that Nelson Mullins receives prior authorization for any out-of-pocket disbursement or costs exceeding US\$200. Administrative costs (telephone, fax, administrative support) are included in the retainer. Payment of the previous month's expenses will be made by Logan upon receipt of the monthly retainer statement.


