

**Title:** Senior Vice President for U.S. Operations.

**Reports to:** STM General Manager, Ankara - TURKIYE.

**Based at:** STM US Liaison Office, Arlington, VA.

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**Responsibilities:**

I. Office Establishment and Defense Product Promotion

- To support STM US Liaison Office establishment.
- To establish and maintain beneficial working relationships between STM and the United States government. Senior Vice President for U.S. Operations will make all required filings and disclosures required by the Foreign Agents Registration Act, the Lobbying Disclosure Act, the Honest Leadership and Open Government Act, and all other applicable legislation, as his activities may dictate. The Senior Vice President for US Operations will have access to legal assistance from the STM attorneys, Saltzman & Evinch, PC to accomplish these required filings and disclosures, though the ultimate responsibility for filing will remain with the Senior Vice President for U.S. Operations.
- To create and nurture beneficial business relationships between STM and US companies, both with their US headquarters and their overseas offices.
- To track, coordinate, manage, and otherwise support current STM or SSM projects in the United States. This includes tracking and supporting defense products exportation and importation applications.
- To develop future action plans for emerging business opportunities and advise accordingly.

II. Regulatory Tracking and Compliance

- To identify and inform STM of relevant portions of the US defense acquisition system and any changes thereto that may affect current and future projects, strictly limited to information available in the public domain. This includes analyzing current law and

proposed legislation that may impact the defense industry, Turkish-US defense cooperation, "Buy American" requirements, export control, free trade, 3rd party transfers, technology transfers.

- To advise and aid STM in complying with all relevant US laws and regulations.
- To participate in exhibitions, meetings, events related to defense industry with the assignment and/or approval of STM.
- To provide written report(s) for the activities performed on monthly basis or as otherwise specifically requested by STM.
