

The Office of the President asked me, Saturday, December 11, 2010, to assist the Cote d'Ivoire Embassy and any public relations firm or publicity agent hired by said Embassy to disseminate the government's point of view with respect to the current crisis resulting from the November 28 presidential runoff. No specific monetary terms were discussed, other than that I will be paid adequate compensation. The agreement is to last the duration of the crisis and may be extended by mutual agreement. Details of a budget, including fees and expenses will be discussed soon.

7. Describe fully the nature and method of performance of the above indicated agreement or understanding.
I am hired to act as a liaison between any hired public relations firm or publicity agent, and the Office of the President. More specifically, I shall be given all necessary or appropriate government and other documents required by said firm or agent to accomplish its or his/her mission. I shall be responsible as well for transmitting requests and other information between the parties. I may also be given money to be held in an escrow account for payment of services rendered by the firm or agent referred to above. Finally, I shall serve, when needed, as a resource person for such firm or agent and may accompany them when meeting third parties to communicate the government's message to the public, the press or political groups or individuals, including giving interviews on radio or television.

8. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

I will meet and work to the degree necessary, with whomever the government hires to represent it for purposes of communicating its point of view to the American public and policy makers. The purpose of such meetings will be to articulate the position of the government or its goals as communicated to me in my liaison capacity. If such hired person or firm needs documents or other resources to do its work, I will transmit the need for such to the government.

I expect to grant interviews to the media on my own initiative or as a result of the work of such hired firm or person. I am not, however, expected to take the lead in any public relations campaign. My main task is to facilitate communication between the government of Cote d'Ivoire and any firm or person it hires in the United States to engage in public relations on its behalf.

If yes, describe all such political activities indicating, among other things, the relations, interests or policies to be influenced together with the means to be employed to achieve this purpose.

With respect to this specific area, I am not expected to lead any initiative. I will undertake such activities only after a hired public relations firm or publicity person determines that I can help their work on behalf of the government of Cote d'Ivoire by appearing with them to see a political figure or entity or by addressing a particular group or individual. I have no public relations or lobbying expertise and therefore can only act to support professionals of that line of work, at their request and direction. I am therefore not in a position to identify what category of persons or groups I may be called to address.
