

As requested, International Merchandising Company LLC ("IMC") hereby responds to the letter of Heather Hunt, US Department of Justice, dated October 16, 2015 requesting additional information in connection with IMC's above referenced Supplemental Statement.

1. In response to your request for additional detail in Item 11 of the Supplemental Statement describing the activities performed by Envoy Strategy Group and Carolyn Mellin specifically for IMC during the six month reporting period, please note that Envoy Strategy Group and Carolyn Mellin have only engaged in private and nonpolitical activities in furtherance of the bona fide trade or commerce of IMC's foreign principal, within the meaning of the exemption from registration under FARA pursuant to 22 U.S.C. § 613(d) and 22 C.F.R. §5.304. Specifically, we are providing the following additional information about their activities for IMC:

a. Envoy Strategy Group (marketing strategy)

-As part of its work for IMC, analyzed US media on pertinent business investments and business trends .

-As part of its work for IMC, researched business conferences to be held in various locations in the US

-As part of its work for IMC, facilitated discussions and meetings with US business journalists to learn their views on various business matters

-As part of its work for IMC, facilitated discussions and meetings with US corporate executives/US business media on investments.

b. Carolyn Mellin (philanthropic consulting)

-As part of her work for IMC, monitored philanthropic trends and activities in the US and internationally
