Dear Mr. Fabiani:

This letter outlines the terms of the on-going relationship of Fabiani (the "Client") and Strategy XXI (the "Agency") as it relates to the Azerbaijan America Alliance.

The Client has retained the Agency, as of June 1, 2011 to assist with work related to the Azerbaijan-America Alliance. The Agency is retained to work on media outreach and other requested outreach efforts for the Alliance in its efforts to present important issues of the Azerbaijan people to the American public. The Agreement is effective as of June 1 and will continue in full force through February 29, 2012, when both parties can agree to continue the engagement. Either party can terminate the Agreement upon not less than sixty (60) days written notice.

The Client has agreed to compensate the Agency for its services in the following manner: June: \$20,000; July: \$25,000; August: \$15,000; September through February, 2012: \$25,000, per month.

The Agency will submit itemized expense invoices to the Client on a monthly basis and those invoices are payable to the Client within 5 business days of the Client's receipt of funds from the Azerbaijan America Alliance. Out-of-pocket expenses, which are incurred on the Client's behalf, such as prorated telephone calls, faxes, subscriptions, photocopying charges, postage and express charges are subject to a 6% commission charge. Travel, defined as business airfare when international, economy when domestic, and hotel and meals while on travel, will be billed at cost. All bills are payable upon receipt. The Agency will not retain third parties or enter into third party contracts without the express written/e-mailed permission of the Client.

The Agency agrees that information and materials provided by the Client to the Agency on a confidential basis shall be held in confidence by the Agency except as otherwise required by law.

The Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the District of Columbia.


