We will inform the U.S. Government about the treatment of Suriname by Alcoa, Inc. Pertinent topics include Alcoa's bauxite and alumina refining activities in Suriname and the Company's termination of those activities.

8. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

We will attempt to assure fair treatment of Suriname in relation to mining and refining operations that are being terminated by Alcoa. Our efforts will include contacting news media, members of Congress, their staff, and other U.S. Government officials, including officials of the Department of State, Department of Commerce, and White House.

9. Will the activities on behalf of the above foreign principal include political activities as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act and in the footnote below? Yes No

If yes, describe all such political activities indicating, among other things, the relations, interests or policies to be influenced together with the means to be employed to achieve this purpose.

The political activities will consist of the contacts described in items 7 and 8 above. Their purpose is to ensure that Suriname obtains appropriate compensation from Alcoa for the loss of employment and related benefits, that it is compensated for injury to the environment caused by Alcoa's activities, and that Alcoa is not permitted to interfere with Suriname's efforts to revive and develop its bauxite and alumina refining industries.

Dear Minister Dodson:

We are looking forward to working as legal adviser for the Ministry of Natural Resources of the Republic of Suriname. We will follow up on the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Government of Suriname (GoS) and the Monaco Resources Group (MRG), which is designed to revive the national bauxite refinery and alumina producing industry of Suriname.

Scope of Legal Services

A negotiation committee has been formed to ensure the successful transfer of the bauxite and alumina refining facilities and associated liabilities currently owned in Suriname by Alcoa. We will provide the legal advice and assistance required for this negotiation committee to successfully achieve the following tasks:

- Negotiate with Alcoa representatives, including its CEO and board members, on the terms for the transfer of facilities and liabilities to the entity established under the MoU. This will involve high-level contacts with Alcoa personnel in the United States and Suriname.
- Carry out lobbying assignments with political representatives, if required, to ensure the desired results from negotiations with Alcoa.
- Draft the agreements required to finalize such transfers.
- Draft the final agreement between the GoS and MRG for bauxite refining and alumina production in Suriname.



- Briefing members of the negotiating committee as to the status of the negotiations with Alcoa and MRG.

Compensation

The Law Office of Bart S. Fisher agrees that it will undertake the assignment described in the scope of legal services section above for a fee of \$15,000 per month for the following four-month period in 2016—the months of June, July, August, and September. Should there be work *after* September 30, 2016, a separate agreement for legal services will be entered into.

The effective date of this agreement is June 1, 2016, and the monthly retainer fee shall be paid within 10 days of each month's invoice. Therefore, the date of payment for the month of June is June 10. Payment for June and other months should be wired as per the following instruction:




