ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LTL STRATEGIES, INC.

To: The Department of Consumer
and Regulatory Affairs
District of Columbia

The undersigned, a natural person of the age of eighteen years or older and acting as incorporator for the purpose of organizing a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the District of Columbia Business Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

FIRST: The name of the corporation (hereinafter called the "corporation") is

LTL STRATEGIES, INC.

SECOND: The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

To own, operate manage, and generally to conduct the business of communication services for any and every lawful purpose in the United States and foreign countries subject to the applicable laws thereof.

To advertise, promote, merchandise and contract with respect to furnishing of the same for or on behalf of any person, firm, or corporation domestic, or foreign to enter into carry out agency or joint arrangement with other persons, firms or corporations engaged in like or similar activities and generally exploit the services and objects of the corporation by all lawful means

To engage in the business of importing and/or exporting goods of every kind, type and description, to purchase and sell such goods as a wholesaler retailer distributor or otherwise to act as an agent or broker in the sale of goods of every kind, type and description - to do all things as are necessary to the accomplishment of the purposes.

To have, in furtherance of the corporate purposes, all of the powers conferred upon corporations organized under the District of Columbia Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,500, all of have no par value and are of the same class and are to be Common shares.

FIFTH: The minimum amount of capital with which the corporation shall commence business will not be less than one thousand dollars.

SIXTH: There are no provisions for preemptive rights.

SEVENTH: There are no provisions for regulation of the internal affairs.

EIGHTH: The address, including street and number, of the initial registered office of the corporation in the District of Columbia is c/o Corporation Service Company, 1090 Vermont Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20005; and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at such address is Corporation Service Company.

NINTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is two (2). The name and the address, including street and number, if any, of each of the persons who are to serve as directors of the corporation until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until their successors be elected and qualify are as follows:

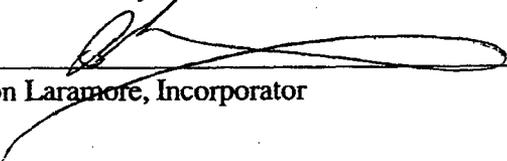
