Innovative Global Initiatives and Solutions, LLC is under contract (attached) to Myrmidon, LLC of New York. That contract explains the functions to be performed by Innovative Global Initiatives and Solutions LLC in support of the Government of the Republika Srpska, specifically the Minister of Economic Development and Regional Cooperation, Zeljka Cvijanovic, and the President of the Republika Srpska, Milorad Dodik. Those functions include explaining the Republika Srpska's perspective on internal Bosnia Herzegovina political, economic, security issues and developments to U.S. and European policymakers; providing information to the U.S. public, to think tanks, to the media concerning these same matters; supporting the Government of the Republika Srpska in its efforts to advance the EU and NATO candidacies of Bosnia Herzegovina.

The principal method involved will be direct contact, through meetings, telephone calls, or written communications. Activities will also include press interviews, participation in and organization of expert discussions.

Consultancy Agreement between Innovative Global Initiatives and Solutions and Myrmidon Group LLC

This document is to serve as a consultancy agreement between Innovative Global Initiatives and Solutions LLC (hereafter IGIS LLC) and Myrmidon Group LLC for the period January – December, 31 2012.

IGIS LLC agrees to act as a subcontractor to Myrmidon Group LLC and designate its principal Amb. Ralph Johnson to work in cooperation and coordination with Myrmidon Group LLC on outreach and external relations in the US in behalf of Republika Srpska. In return IGIS will be compensated with a monthly fee of \$ 15,000 per month. As a subcontractor, IGIS LLC and Amb. Johnson are responsible for all payments of taxes to US, state and municipal authorities and for all necessary registration with U.S. authorities and all record-keeping required for their lobbying and outreach work.

IGIS LLC's and Amb. Johnson's work will be to provide major input into the implementation and realization of Myrmidon Group LLC's contract with the Government of Republika Srpska and its Ministry of Economic Relations and Regional Cooperation. IGIS LLC's focus will be on relations with the U.S. Government, the State Department, the U.S. Congress, and policy analysts.

It is understood that this contract is with IGIS LLC, but specifically for Amb. Johnson's services and may not be subcontracted to any other implementer in whole or in part without written agreement from Myrmidon Group LLC's Managing Partner, Adrian Karatnyck.

This agreement with IGIS LLC may be terminated by Myrmidon Group LLC with two weeks notice without cause; however such termination could not occur without the consent of the client—the Government of Repulika Srpska. Should IGIS LLC and Amb. Johnson choose to end his relationship with Myrmidon, they can do so unilaterally with one month's notice.

The consultancy will be paid on a monthly basis and is not linked to a specific number of work days, but rather to the realization of a plan of activities defined in a contract signed with

Republika Srpska and shared with IGIS LLC and Amb. Johnson.


Travel, per diem and any additional expenses incurred will covered by the monthly fee with no additional payments, except by mutual agreement.

Should there be any interruptions in payments to Myrmidon Group LLC as a result of actions or decisions by Republika Srpska, Myrmidon Group LLC shall not be liable for payment to IGIS LLC or to Amb. Johnson. Should the Republika Srpska cancel its contract at any time for whatever reason, this contract shall also be considered null and void from the moment of cancellation notwithstanding any provisions listed above.


Payments will be made to IGIS LLC upon receipt of a signed monthly invoice to be received by email the middle of each month and payable no later than by the end of each month, provided there are no delays or interruptions in payment as indicated in the paragraph immediately above.

IGIS LLC and Amb. Johnson obligate to maintain an accurate log of his activities as required by FARA legislation and as required for lobbyist registers with the U.S. Congress and to abide by guidelines and as indicated in a memo from Grayson Yeargin of Nixon & Peabody, a legal counsel to Myrmidon Group LLC, dated August 16th 2011. IGIS LLC and Amb. Johnson further agree to comply with all registration and tax documentation required by U.S. or state law. Amb. Johnson further confirms he has full corporate authority to enter into this agreement on behalf of IGIS LLC.
