CCPIT was established by the Chinese government in 1952, it has played a very important role in developing China's international economic relations over different historical periods of China's economic development.


CCPIT is solely funded and sponsored by the Chinese government under the direct authority of the State Council. The personnel of CCPIT are government employees.


