ULCPFR has been engaging and will continue to engage in initiatives benefiting all the registrant's foreign principals, including:

- a) Educating the general public about the plight of the citizens of Laos in urban areas as well as in the highlands;
- b) Lobbying government officials of all levels, European congress, the UN and ASEAN to pressure the communist Lao government to end its persecution, oppression, and discrimination against ethnic Hmong in the highlands.
- c) Seeking humanitarian aids from international communities for the victim of human rights abuse in Laos; and
- d) Working with the U.S. government, European congress, the UN an ASEAN to bring peaceful resolution in Laos.
