They call us by phones regularly asking for money to buy foods, medicines, flashlight batteries and other necessities. We have been sending them small amount of a couple hundred dollars monthly. Also, the Director of ULCPFR Human Rights Division, Mr. Vaughn Vang, has worked closely with the Center for Public Policy Analysis in Washington, D.C. updating them of communist Lao various human rights abuses/violations and attacks on the innocent Lao people, especially recent cases of human/drug trafficking, land grabbing/contracting and timberwoods devastating and wild animals killing in Luang Namtha, Bokeo, Phongsaly, Oudomxay, Luang Prabang, Xieng Khouang, Saysomboun, Thakhek, Savannakhet, Saravane, Sekong, Attapeu and Champassak provinces and robberies/shootings in Vientiane.

1. The Chairman of European ULC Chapter has written letters concerning human rights abuses/violations by the communist regime in Laos to the European Foreign Ministries (Britain and France), U.S. Embassy in Paris, France and the United Nations.

The Executive Committee has conducted numerous Meetings across MN, WI, and CA, briefing the Lao-Hmong-American communities about the reforming and progress of ULCPFR with the necessary documents and updated information on conditions inside Laos and U.S. policy of Rebalance in Asia-Pacific, focusing on U.S. Aids programs in Laos.
3. The Executive Committee and Secretariat have conducted a Fundraising Party on March 22, 2014 in Brooklyn Park, MN, to send a ULCPFR delegation to D.C. to meet with our U.S. leaders in the near future. We have been listening and collecting local issues of concerns regarding ULCPFR. We also attended the 50th Vietnam War Commemoration in Manitowoc, Wisconsin, on September 21, 2013.

MN and CA Branches of ULCPFR have been sending small amount of money to foreign principal(s) upon receiving calls for help to buy medicines, foods, flashlight batteries and miscellaneous things for personal uses.

The Executive Committee has also attended regularly Lao-Hmong-American communities' cultural, social and educational activities taking the opportunities to advocate for ULCPFR support, especially Foreign Principal(s) needs and the challenges they are facing.


