As a point of introduction, my firm does some outreach on behalf of the Azerbaijani embassy here in the United States.

I wanted to make sure you saw this press release from Virginia-based Orbital Sciences Corporation alerting that the first-ever Azerbaijani telecommunications satellite is ready to be deployed. The satellite will provide broadband Internet, data, voice and broadcasting services to the South Caucasus, Europe, Central Asia and African countries.

It is scheduled to be launched tomorrow, Feb. 7, from French Guiana.

This will be the first satellite launched by any country from South Caucasus region.

The launch and deployment of the satellite is the result of a contract that was signed in June 2010, was valued at US\$205.3 million, and helped support 1,500 U.S. jobs.

I've pulled the Ambassador's quote here:

"The launch of Azerbaijan's first telecommunications satellite marks an important milestone in the successful partnership with U.S. industry and the Government of Azerbaijan," said Azerbaijani ambassador to the United States Elin Suleymanov. "We look forward to the launch of the satellite, which will address current and future communications needs of Azerbaijan, the Caucasus Region, Central Asia, Europe and Africa."

--30th Orbital-built Commercial GEOStar Satellite Will Provide Communications Services for Azerbaijan, Europe, Africa, Middle East and Central Asia --

(Dulles, VA 6 February 2013)- Orbital Sciences Corporation (NYSE:ORB), one of the world's leading space technology companies, announced today that it is in final preparations for the launch of the Azerspace/Africasat-1a commercial communications satellite for Azercosmos, Open Joint Stock Company of the Ministry of Communications and Information Technologies of the Republic of Azerbaijan. Designed, manufactured and tested at Orbital's Dulles, Virginia satellite production facilities, Azerspace/Africasat-1a is scheduled to be launched aboard an Ariane 5 rocket from Kourou, French Guiana on February 7, 2013.

Following its launch, the satellite will undergo in-orbit testing and verification that all subsystems are operating as planned. Once testing is complete and the spacecraft is positioned at its orbital location, day-to-day operations of Azerspace/Africasat-1a will be handed over to Azercosmos, which will continue to operate the spacecraft from its control centers in Baku and Nakhchivan, Azerbaijan. These facilities were designed and built by Azercosmos to support the installation of the ground control systems provided by Orbital, including ground antennas, radio-frequency electronics, computer platforms, and the software used to command, monitor and control the Azerspace/Africasat-1a satellite.

"The launch of Azerbaijan's first telecommunications satellite marks an important milestone in the successful partnership with U.S. industry and the Government of Azerbaijan," said Azerbaijani ambassador to the United States Elin Suleymanov. "We look forward to the launch of the satellite, which will address current and future communications needs of Azerbaijan, the Caucasus Region, Central Asia, Europe and Africa."

With an anticipated service life of 15 years, Azerspace/Africasat-1a is based on Orbital's flight-proven GEOStar-2 platform. The hybrid C- and Ku-band satellite will generate approximately five kilowatts of payload power and carry 36 active transponders, providing communications services to Azerbaijan, Europe, Africa, Middle East and Central Asia. Azerspace/Africasat-1a will operate from an orbital location at 46 degrees East longitude through an arrangement between Azercosmos and MEASAT Satellite Systems of Malaysia, which owns the rights to the orbital slot.

"The Azerspace/Africasat-1a satellite is a critical component for the Republic of Azerbaijan to expand its communications infrastructure and enhance connectivity with other parts of the world," said Mr. Christopher Richmond, Orbital's Senior Vice President of Communications Satellites. "This is the tenth GEOStar-2 satellite we've built in the last two years. We are now finishing our preparations and gearing up for a successful launch."

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





FIRST AZERBAIJANI TELECOMMUNICATIONS SATELLITE LAUNCHES INTO SPACE



February 7, 2013 – Azerbaijan's first telecommunications satellite, the [Azerspace/Africasat-1a](#) was successfully launched into orbit today from French Guyana marking the first Arian Space launch this year.

"This is a proud day for the people of Azerbaijan," said Azerbaijan Ambassador to the United States Elin Suleymanov. "The successful launch of Azerbaijan's first telecommunications satellite marks an important milestone in the successful partnership with U.S. industry and the Government of Azerbaijan. This satellite will address current and future communications needs of Azerbaijan, the Caucasus Region, Central Asia, Europe and Africa. The launch is also a fitting beginning for 2013, declared the year of Information and Communications Technologies in Azerbaijan by President Ilham Aliyev, and illustrates the Government's policy of economic diversification and promoting new technologies."

Virginia-based Orbital Sciences Corporation designed, built, and delivered the state-of-the-art communications satellite as part of a \$205 million contract with the Azercosmos, an Open Joint Stock Company of the Ministry of Communications and Information Technologies of the Republic of Azerbaijan. The satellite construction supported 1,500 U.S. jobs and is an example of the important bilateral relationship between the U.S. and Azerbaijan, America's largest trade partner from the South Caucasus.

As the first national telecommunications satellite for Azerbaijan and for the South Caucasus, the Azerspace/Africasat-1a will provide important broadband Internet, data, voice and broadcasting services to Central Asia, Europe and Africa during its 15-year mission life. Azerbaijan-based Azercosmos will handle operational control of the satellite from control centers in Baku and Nakhchivan, Azerbaijan, once in-orbit testing is completed by Orbital.
