

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

Under Section 402 of the Business Corporation Law

The undersigned, a natural person of the age of eighteen years or over, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the Business Corporation Law of the State of New York, does hereby certify and set forth:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Karv Communications, Inc.

SECOND: The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To advise and to consult with respect to communications, public affairs, crisis management and other business matters and to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Business Corporation Law, provided that the corporation is not formed to engage in any act or activity requiring the consent or approval of any state official, department, board, agency or other body without such consent or approval first being obtained.

For the accomplishment of the aforesaid purposes, and in furtherance thereof, the corporation shall have and may exercise all of the powers, rights and privileges which are now and may hereafter be conferred by the Business Corporation Law upon corporations formed thereunder, subject to any limitations thereof contained in the laws of the State of New York.


THIRD: The office of the corporation within the State of New York is to be located in the County of New York.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue shall be two thousand, each of which shall be Common Stock, par value \$10 per share.
