The registrant has provided advice to the fp on attracting investment from the U.S. The registrant has also disseminated investment, tourism and economic data materials on behalf of the fp. The registrant has also conveyed information on behalf of the fp to the U.S. Administration and Congress related to issues of concern to both the fp and the U.S. On occasion the registrant has also appeared in local and international media to promote interest in the fp for investment.
