**CONTRACT FOR SERVICES**

This Independent Contractor Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into this 21<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2015, by and between Your Global Strategy, Inc., ("Consultant") and GloBee, the International Agency for Regional Development (the "Client").

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the Client is in need of assistance for the work specified in Schedule A, and WHEREAS Consultant has agreed to perform independent work in these related activities for the Client;


NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. **Consultant's services.** Consultant shall be available and shall provide to the Client professional services as outlined in the attached proposal, and as later modified by mutual agreement. ~~Consultant shall not be responsible for any delays or cancellations of meetings or other activities specified in Schedule A, and the~~ understanding that certain meetings and levels of interlocutor cannot always be guaranteed in advance.
2. **Consideration.** In consideration of the Services to be performed by Consultant under this Agreement the Client will pay Consultant at a rate of \$12,000 for the specified services. Reimbursement for expenses expended by Consultant on behalf of the Client should be pre-approved by an officer of the Client. This shall be the sole consideration (except for legitimate expense reimbursements) due Consultant for the services rendered hereunder.
3. **Confidentiality.** In the course of performing consulting services, Contractor agrees to keep all proprietary information confidential and not to discuss or divulge it to anyone other than appropriate Client personnel, its designees, or those the Client and Consultant have agreed would be essential to know such information.
4. **Term.** This Agreement shall commence on **January 7, 2016**, and shall terminate not later than **March 5, 2016**, unless earlier terminated by either party hereto, or if an extension is requested by Consultant and approved by Client. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon five (5) days prior written notice, either by written or electronic means.
5. **Payment.** Client will transfer \$5,000 to Contractor upon approval of contract, and the balance (\$7,000) upon completion of the project as outlined in Schedule A.


