(Registrant 6200) including support in connection with Dickens & Madson's representation of Anayurt Libya, a wholly owned subsidiary of the Libyan Investment and Development Company (LIDCO), to support the Unified Libya Movement (ULM). Mr. Hughes' role is expected to include lobbying/contact with the legislative and executive branches of the government of the United States and government agencies concerning Dickens & Madson Canada and its efforts on behalf of the ULM. Mr. Hughes is expected to be in contact with both the ULM and United States policy makers, opinion leaders and members of the press with respect to ULM activities and the mission set out in its charter. Mr. Hughes is further expected to provide consultation, negotiation and mediation services as necessary. Adams Jones Law Firm, P.A. has not reached a definitive agreement with Dickens & Madson Canada regarding the compensation for Mr. Hughes' services or other terms of service, but, in the past has performed work for Dickens & Madson Canada on an hourly basis at prevailing rates.
