The firm has provided information based on the personal knowledge and experience of the individual working on the project as well as sources in the public domain, including news articles concerning Congressional action on Trade Promotion Authority, developments on TPP negotiations and other issues of interest to the Ministry. The firm has not initiated conversations with US government officials to obtain information for this client.
