ATTACHMENT B TO SUPPLEMENTAL FILING –
Item 5(d) Short Form Terminations in last 6 months

During the past 6 months, Russell Orban, a Husch Blackwell LLP attorney, terminated his Short Form Registration for the Kingdom of Morocco, Ministry of the Handicrafts and Social & Collaborative Economy on 04/27/2015. As his Short Form Registration is terminated, he has not since performed any work on behalf of any foreign principal. We also terminated his listing on our Registration statement as an employee who renders services on behalf of foreign principals on the same date.

In addition, on 04/24/2015, Husch Blackwell LLP filed the official Short Form terminations with respect to attorneys Charles Nottingham and Singleton McAllister for Burkina Faso. Husch Blackwell LLP and any of its employees ceased providing services for this foreign principal on June 23, 2014 but did not file the official FARA termination until 4/24/15. We also noted that we were no longer providing services for this foreign principal on our Initial Filing dated 01/16/2015. Because Charles Nottingham ceased to work for Husch Blackwell LLP on November 14, 2014, we also terminated his listing on our Registration Statement as an employee who renders services on behalf of foreign principals on the same date.

ATTACHMENT C TO SUPPLEMENTAL FILING –
Item 11 Services Rendered to Foreign Principals in last 6 months

During the past 6 months, Husch Blackwell, LLP (“Husch”) rendered services only on behalf of its foreign principal the Kingdom of Morocco, Ministry of the Handicrafts and Social and Collaborative Economy (“Morocco”) through its subcontract with Blue Mountain Solutions, LLC (“Blue Mountain”). Services were provided by Singleton McAllister and Russell Orban as described in Husch’s Exhibit AB for Morocco and the Short Form Registrations of Singleton McAllister and Russell Orban. None of these services constituted “political activity” as defined under relevant law.

Specifically, the services provided for Morocco by Husch in the last six months included the following:

- Singleton McAllister sent invitations to individuals and Members of Congress to attend an event at the Library of Congress to celebrate Moroccan handicrafts and the rich cultural traditions of Morocco.
- Singleton McAllister also reached out to the Secretary of the Virginia Commonwealth and the director of the African Museum of Art to bring greetings at the reception.
- Singleton McAllister also made follow-up emails and phone calls to invited individuals and handled the RSVP list.
- Singleton McAllister provided a list of suggested names for the Moroccan Ambassador to invite to a private dinner but neither sent nor drafted the invitations. It did however follow up with those invited and kept an RSVP list.
- Russell Orban reached out to the U.S. Chamber of Commerce to set up a meeting with the Minister of Handicrafts to inform the Chamber with regard to the Moroccan handicraft sector. This was his only activity on behalf of any foreign principal, and he subsequently terminated his short form registration.
