

### LETTER OF AGREEMENT

This agreement is reached between Abdellah Aadnani, General Manager, Ministry of Handicrafts, Social and Solidarity Economy, Kingdom of Morocco (the Ministry) and Alfreda V. Davis, President, Blue Mountain Solutions, LLC, a licensed entity doing business in Washington, the District of Columbia, United States of America, (the Contractor) to provide services to promote awareness of the rich cultural traditions of the Moroccan handicraft sector and support its continued growth, consistent with the US Millenium Challenge Corporation's framework of cooperation.

This purpose shall be accomplished through the planning and execution of: (1) an Artisans Showcase in the City of Alexandria, Virginia from April 26-29, 2015 a promotional event that is the precursor to the Moroccan Village Festival to be held later in 2015; and (2) a series of ancillary activities coinciding with the Artisans Showcase, that will be held in the Greater Washington Metropolitan area to promote the Showcase and to highlight the spirit of cooperation and collaboration which exists between Morocco and the United States. These

ancillary events include: a Hosted Reception, Engagement and Advocacy Meetings, and a National Press Club Event. In addition, there are Audio-Visual, Marketing/Communications and Project Management activities that will span all events.

Blue Mountain Solutions, LLC and its agents are authorized under the terms of this agreement to represent the Ministry in the contact of U.S. individuals and entities for the purposes of: peer-to-peer introductions; scheduling of meetings to discuss Moroccan interests and initiatives in expansion of its Handicraft label; and the planning and execution of promotional events, consistent with Ministry directives. Nothing in this agreement shall be construed to grant independent authority to Blue Mountain Solutions, LLC to act outside of the intended scope of this agreement.

Mr. Mohamed Eljaam, President, AV Actions; and Ms. Singleton B. McAllister, Of Counsel, Husch and Blackwell, LLP. are approved subcontractors under this agreement who will carry out responsibilities for specified. approved compensation. Specifically, Mr. Eljaam shall provide all audio-visual needs. Ms. McAllister, shall direct the advocacy and engagement activities.

Mr. Adil Ibnoutalib, Counselor to the Ministry and Ms. Alfreda V. Davis have been designated as the Points of Contact for this project.

This document constitutes the agreement in its entirety. No changes may be made without the mutual written agreement of both parties.

The Contractor and any subcontractors shall use their best efforts to promote and increase the visibility of the Moroccan handicraft brand. The total value of this contract shall not exceed Fifty Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, US (\$58,500 USD).
