

The agreement is to promote foreign direct investment, including US investment, into Vietnam. The method by which this is agreed to be done is by writing and presenting white papers at the Harvard and Yale Clubs of New York City, and to release white papers on the Corr Analytics website canalyt.com, and by following up with investors and media to encourage investment and media coverage for the papers, and for interviews that would encourage investment in Vietnam. Additional agreements include writing and presentation of white papers on security issues in the Pacific, and on cyber-security.

8. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

Corr Analytics promotes investment into Vietnam with various private equity funds, and other institutional investors. Corr Analytics does this through the media, appearances, meetings, research, and writing. Corr Analytics provides analysis and advice to Mr. Tuan Nguyen and Vietnam Report in furtherance of Vietnamese interests, including on economics, investment, and politics. Corr Analytics writes and presents white papers on security in the Pacific, and on cyber-security.



By promoting investment from the United States into Vietnam, and vice-versa, and by promoting trade between the two countries, this could improve relations between the two countries and lead to normalization of diplomatic relations. Writing and presentation of white papers on security issues in the Pacific, including on cyber-security globally, could improve relations between Vietnam and the United States, and increase the likelihood of peace in the Pacific region and elsewhere.



Consulting Contract Between Vietnam Report and Corr Analytics

1. This is a Contract between the Vietnamese Company, Vietnam Report, and Corr Analytics Inc. (New York, NY, USA).
2. Upon execution of this contract, Corr Analytics may register and/or inform one or more agencies of the United States government that Corr Analytics is providing consulting services to Vietnam Report. Registration and informing the United States government will occur, to be in accordance with United States law, within 10 days of the execution of the agreement. For more information, see <http://www.fara.gov/fara-faq.html>. This registration and or informing of the United States Government may or may not be made available to the general public, at the discretion of the United States Government. Corr Analytics may disclose the terms of the contract as it sees fit, for example if it is required to do so for full disclosure purposes to a media company.
3. Vietnam Report agrees to pay a retainer to Corr Analytics of \$5000 US Dollars. This retainer will be used for labor and other expenses necessary for production of a white paper (at least 15 pages) addressing the investment environment in Vietnam. Upon receipt of \$5000 by Corr Analytics from Vietnam Report, this contract will be executed.
4. Labor costs are as follows:
 - a. Senior Associates (Consultants with an M.A. or Ph.D. degree): \$100 per hour.
 - b. Associates (Consultants with a B.A. degree): \$80 per hour.
 - c. Research Assistants: \$50 per hour.
5. Labor may be delegated to Senior Associates, Associates and Research Assistants at the rates specified above, at the sole discretion of Corr Analytics Inc.
6. Expenses other than labor, for example travel or legal expenses related to registration, must be approved by Vietnam Report's representative, Mr. Tuan Nguyen (hereinafter "Representative"), prior to funds being obligated.
7. The lead author of the white paper, Anders Corr, will obligate at least 10-20 hours per week to the report.
8. If funds remain after the report is complete, the funds will be returned to the Representative in US Dollars by means of a US check denominated in US Dollars. If the report is not complete after expenditure of the retainer, additional funds will be requested by Corr Analytics from the Representative for completion of the report. Disbursement of additional funds, and continuation of work on the white paper, will at that time as at other times be at the sole discretion of the Representative.
9. The Representative may at any time choose to terminate the relationship with Corr Analytics, in which case all unused funds, as well as drafts, electronic data, and research materials, will be provided to the Representative.
10. All intellectual and property rights resulting from research compensated according to this contract, including electronic and other rights to dissemination, will be the sole ownership of Vietnam Report.

Consulting Contract Between Vietnam Report and Corr Analytics

11. Milestones will be reported to the Representative as they are completed. The deadlines and milestones are detailed in points a-e below:

- a. Week 0: Retainer of \$5000 received by Corr Analytics from the Representative or Vietnam Report. Contract is then considered executed.
- b. Week 1: Outline due from Corr Analytics to Representative.
- c. Week 2: Comments due from Representative to Corr Analytics.
- d. Week 3: First draft due from Corr Analytics to Representative.
- e. Week 4: Comments due from Representative to Corr Analytics.
- f. Week 6: Second and final draft due from Corr Analytics to Representative.

The deadline is no later than 25th November, 2014.

12. The milestones and timeline above may be changed by mutual agreement of Corr Analytics and the representative. Any changes must be made in writing to take effect.


