

CONSULTING AGREEMENT


This will confirm the Agreement of the Alpine Group, Inc. (the "Firm") and Impact Management Group ("IMG") with respect to the performance of certain government relations consulting services.

- 1) During the term of this Agreement, the Firm will render services to IMG, as directed by Terrell E. Benham, on behalf of the Georgian Dream Political Party ("Georgian Dream").
- 2) It is understood and agreed, with respect to the services the Firm shall render pursuant to paragraph 1 above, that the Firm will perform such services exclusively as an independent subcontractor to IMG, and not as an agent or employee of, Georgian Dream.
- 3) The Firm will hold in a fiduciary capacity for the benefit of IMG all secret or confidential information, data or policies relating to Georgian Dream that shall have been obtained by the Firm during the term of this Agreement.
- 4) The term of this Agreement shall commence on August 29, 2016 and shall continue in effect until October 8, 2016.
- 5) (a) For all the services and undertakings of the Firm hereunder during the term of this Agreement, IMG shall pay to the Firm a retainer of \$22,500.00. Payment in full of this retainer shall be due on September 5, 2016.

(b) The retainer specified in paragraph 5(a) includes ordinary and customary expenses. Any additional expenses to be charged to IMG by the Firm must be approved in advance by IMG.
- 6) Either party may terminate this Agreement by providing written notice thirty (30) days in advance of such termination. The Firm will refund any fees paid in advance for services beyond the termination date to IMG.


