The Registrant has been entrusted by its principal, the League of Arab States with headquarters in Cairo, Egypt, to operate an information center within the United States of America. The Registrant is operating under general instructions and will continue to operate so long as the League of Arab States authorizes it or until it terminates the functions of this office. The Registrant operates under an annual budget fixed by its principal, the League of Arab States which covers all its expenses and we report semi-annually to the Department of Justice the income received and the expenditures expended. In addition, we receive occasionally, small sums as payment for subscriptions to The Arab World which sums are also reported in the said semi-annual report.

- The Registrant uses all of the normal operating means of such an information center, such as its staff members giving lectures to requesting groups, appearing on radio and TV interviews (as requested), answering by letters, telephones and personal contacts the requests for information made by the public and on occasion, sending letters to newspaper editors, showing (on request) available films on the culture and development of the Arab world and distributing publications which serve the aims described above.


